



## PARKS' OVERALL WORK PROJECTS

### AL SMITH PARK

Basketball goal and backboard replaced-COMPLETED

Fix and replace lattice-NOT COMPLETED

### 7<sup>TH</sup> STREET PARK



Replaced one basketball net-COMPLETED

Remulch playground area and replace pads-NOT COMPLETED

### MARTIN LUTHER KING PARK

Replaced two basketball goals; play area re-mulched-COMPLETED

Pads needed under slides, replace one park bench, repaired or replaced rails-NOT COMPLETED

### LARROUX PARK

Fixed and repaired lattice on gazebo-COMPLETED

Mulch around the perimeter of garden; one basketball net needed-NOT COMPLETED

### CAROL VEGAS (CITY) PARK

Removed grass from sandbox, replaced sand, remulched total area-COMPLETED

## COMMAGERE FOOTBALL FIELD

Parking barriers, consisting of 4x4s, concrete and rope, have been installed; football goals have been sanded and painted; placed a new storage shed for equipment on the Park property...all these projects have been COMPLETED.

Removal of old scoreboard before it falls, with the potential to injure someone, which would put the city in a libelous situation-NOT COMPLETE.

## COMMAGERE SOFTBALL FIELD

Replaced two restroom doors and concession door, including replacing locks; replaced tin roofs in baseball dugouts; dumped one load of sandy clay in infield; resurfaced and removed all the grass from infield-COMPLETED

Pressure wash, paint and replace all rotten wood that comprises the soffit-NOT COMPLETED

## COMPLEX

Removed two and one half (2 ½) feet of grass from the infields of ball fields one and five to meet the compliance of the measurements of the bases; field one's scoreboard has been repaired; the stairwells for fields one, five and six press boxes have been sanded and repainted; removed the load of dirt from the Complex entrance; repaired water leak behind field five; repaired and re-hung all gates; removed all carpet and repainted both batting cages; replaced vanity in girls' bathroom; replaced burned out field lights; parking and security lights have now been reworked to come on automatically at dusk-COMplete.

Replace turf in batting cages; repair all rotten wood in all dugouts (up to 12); repair or dismantle white storage shed, which has evidence of termites; remove old scoreboard from field five; pressure wash/clean on bathroom and concession stand buildings; flagpole light needs new ballast; repaint all foul poles (12)-NOT COMPLETED
