
**Re: Splash Pad Restroom**

**The Public Works Department and contractor met with Christine Woodell of C & L Ventures, Inc. in May of 2013. Mrs. Woodell is an ADA Training and Technical Assistance Expert.**

**When we met with her she inspected the restrooms and it was determined that the restrooms was compliant with the regulations prior to March of 2012, but since the building permit was issued in early May of 2012 the facilities were not compliant.**

**Her recommendations were to begin work on the handicapped restroom and open the non handicapped restroom to the general public.**

**The contractor has done the demolition work and is in the reconstruction phase of the work process and plans to be finished by the end of July**

**Highlights:**

Our drainage crews have been busy solving some drainage issues, doing needed drainage maintenance, and doing main drainage cleaning throughout the entire city.

**Ward 1: Vine Circle, Dan Russell Dr, and Jackson Blvd.**

**Ward 2: Demontluzin St. and State St.**

**Ward 3: St Francis and St John's St.**

**Ward 4: Central Ave, Third St, Citizen St, 6th St, and Pecan Park**

**Ward 5: Fiber St. and Huckleberry Rd**

**Ward 6: Honshu St, Robin St, Ireland St, and Jordan River Dr.**

Along with their ditch maintenance work 12 driveway culverts were set and 4 sets of culverts set closing the frontage ditches.

With all this drainage work the crew also spent 3 days performing the demolition and cleaning of the blighted property on Azalea St. and removal of the old asphalt tennis courts at MLK Park.

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**Re: 8<sup>th</sup> Street Pole Yard**
