# A RESOLUTION BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BAY ST. LOUIS, MISSISSIPPI, APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE FY 2019-2020 BUDGET AS FINALLY DETERMINED BY THE CITY GOVERNING AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, the City of Bay St. Louis, as a municipal corporation in the State of Mississippi, is required to operate on a fiscal year basis beginning October 1st and ending September 30th each year; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Authority of the City is also required by no later than September 15th of each year to prepare a complete budget of the municipal revenues, expenses, and working cash balances estimated for the next fiscal year for municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Authority, having first held at least one public hearing to provide the general public with an opportunity to comment on the taxing and spending plan incorporated in the proposed budget at least one (1) week prior hereto, does hereby find that the proposed budget as amended and attached hereto should be adopted, as finally determined hereby, as the budget for the City of Bay St. Louis for the fiscal year of October 1, 2019, to September 30, 2020, and entered in fund, department, and purpose level (as per attached exhibit) in the official minutes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BAY ST. LOUIS, MISSISSIPPI, AS FOLLOWS, TO WIT:

**Section 1.** The matters, facts and things recited in the Preamble hereto are hereby adopted as the official findings of the Governing Authority.

**Section 2.** The proposed budget as amended, prepared and attached hereto should be, and hereby is, adopted as the budget for the City of Bay St. Louis, as finally determined hereby, for the fiscal year of October 1, 2019, to September 30, 2020, and should further be entered in fund, department, and purpose level (as per attached exhibit).

**Section 3.** That this Resolution be, and it is hereby ordered to be spread on the minutes of the Governing Authority, and to be in full force and effect as provided by law.
